Today – A mixture of clouds and sun are expected much of the day as periods of high clouds filter across the area. A stronger southwest wind component should keep the sea breeze very close to the coast and this likely leads to hot temperatures near 90 degrees Sunday afternoon. Wind gusts of 20-25 mph will also develop. If the sea breeze manages to develop then temperatures will remain in the 80s with lighter winds also possible. **Sunrise: 5:00am / Sunset: 8:27pm**
