Today – Mostly sunny becoming partly cloudy this afternoon along with hazy skies. Dry conditions will occur this morning, with an isolated shower or thunderstorm becoming possible after 4pm. The temperature will reach a high near 90°F, with the heat index topping out in the mid-90s. Light and variable winds will become northwesterly by mid-morning. Expect northerly winds to increase after 2pm, becoming sustained at 10-15 mph with gusts in the 15-20 mph range. **Sunrise: 6:31am / Sunset: 8:28pm**

Extended forecast – A few thunderstorms will remain possible this evening and overnight, with any rainfall likely to hold below 0.25". The highest precipitation chances will arrive after 9pm. After any lingering showers diminish by 8am, expect dry conditions for the remainder of Friday as a cooler, drier airmass moves into the region behind the front. Weak upper-level disturbances may set off overnight/early morning complexes of showers and thunderstorms across western/central Nebraska this weekend, but precipitation probabilities remain low as there is considerable uncertainty that any of this activity will be able to maintain into eastern Nebraska.
