Extended Forecast – A weak front will push into northern Missouri tonight and then towards southern Missouri on Sunday. There is a low threat for weakening showers/T-storms Sunday morning, otherwise the greater threat for precipitation should be during the afternoon. The highest precipitation chances are expected between 3-7pm but this will be dependent on the location of the front. Additional showers/T-storms are possible on Monday as the front stalls out over the region.
