**Today** — A slight threat for a shower/T-storm will exist this morning as an outflow boundary pushes through the area around 8am. The more likely period of shower/T-storm development should hold off until the afternoon and early evening, with the 3-8pm timeframe favored. Temperatures should climb to near 90 degrees. Initial southwest winds could become erratic during the day, especially behind the outflow boundary. Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.25" with locally higher amounts possible in T-storms. **Sunrise: 6:11am / Sunset: 8:26pm**

Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.25" with locally higher amounts possible in T-storms.
