Any development likely remains widely scattered in nature. Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.25".

Extended Forecast – With the recent rains and clearing skies tonight, areas of fog development are possible. There will be some slightly drier air working into the area overnight so this could keep fog patchy, at worst. For Saturday through Monday, warm and humid conditions will be in place with a low chance for an afternoon shower/T-storm. Given the lack of upper-level forcing, coverage likely remains spotty with Sunday and Monday afternoon favored for development. Winds will remain light and out of the south through the weekend with temperatures in the upper 80s.
