**Extended Forecast** – With ample moisture and instability in place, showers/T-storms will remain possible tonight and into early Friday morning. Activity should diminish by sunrise Friday as an upper-level disturbance shifts eastward. Some shower/T-storm redevelopment could occur late Friday afternoon along a weak frontal boundary, however confidence remains low. The threat for precipitation should lower significantly Saturday and especially Sunday with limited upper-level forcing. If any development occurred it would remain isolated in nature.
