











Extended Forecast – A front drops in from the north tonight, bringing isolated showers and breezy conditions with gusts to 25 mph possible. Cloudy skies and a few showers linger into Saturday morning before skies clear for the afternoon. Tomorrow will be cooler with highs in the upper 80's and winds turning north to northeast at 10-15 mph, gusting to 20 mph. High pressure sets up for Sunday, providing mostly sunny skies and nice weather. Winds will be out of the east-southeast at 8-14 mph for the final round with a high in the upper 80's.
