Things to Know

- Field headlined by seven of the top 10 in the Korn Ferry Tour points standings
- Former Dallas Cowboys quarterback and current NFL on CBS analyst Tony Romo will compete as an amateur on a sponsor exemption
- Dallas residents in the field are headlined by Davis Riley and Brandon Wu, who sit fifth and seventh in the Korn Ferry Tour points standings, respectively

- 21 of the top 25 in the Korn Ferry Tour standings, led by No. 2 Stephan Jaeger
- 54 past Korn Ferry Tour winners with 79 total victories, led by **Martin Piller** and **Stephan Jaeger** with six apiece

- No. 2 Stephan Jaeger, No. 5 Davis Riley and No. 10 Jared Wolfe are each seeking a third win for immediate
 promotion to PGA TOUR; Trailing by only four points entering this week's tournament, a made cut would
 catapult Jaeger past Will Zalatoris for the top spot in the Korn Ferry Tour points standings, a spot Zalatoris

has held for the past 14 events; Zalatoris, a Dallas resident, earned Special Temporary Membership on the PGA TOUR last fall after four top-20 finishes in five starts and finished runner-up at the Masters Tournament two weeks ago

- Tony Romo is making his second career start in a Korn Ferry Tour event and sixth in a PGA TOUR-sanctioned event; he competed last summer in the Korn Ferry Tour's Price Cutter Charity Championship presented by Dr Pepper (WD) and has played in four PGA Tour events since 2018, missing the cut at the Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship twice (2018-2019), as well as at the AT&T Byron Nelson and Safeway Open in 2019
- Eight qualifiers gained entry into the field at two sites on Monday, highlighted by former Texas Longhorn Toni Hakula, who shot a 62 at Trophy Club Country Club's Hogan course
- The Veritex Bank Championship is the sixth Korn Ferry Tour tournament of 2021 and 29th of the season

- Paiute Golf Resort's Sun Mountain course hosted the Korn Ferry Tour last week for the inaugural MGM Resorts Championship at Paiute in Las Vegas
- Peter Uihlein carded a front-nine 32 on Sunday to open his lead and coasted to a four-stroke victory; the win was the second of his Korn Ferry Tour career and first since the 2017 Nationwide Children's Hospital Championship, which came in Uihlein's first start as a professional on the Korn Ferry Tour
- With the win, Uihlein advanced from 73rd to 23rd in the Korn Ferry Tour points standings
- David Lipsky, a Las Vegas resident, claimed his second consecutive runner-up finish to put himself on the
 verge of securing his first PGA TOUR card in his 11th year as a pro; Lipsky won the TPC San Antonio
 Challenge at the Canyons last July and currently sits fourth in the standings
- A trio of current Dallas residents, **Taylor Moore** (4th), **Braden Thornberry** (T5) and **Austin Smotherman** (T9) secured top-10 finishes heading into the Veritex Bank Championship

Korn Ferry Tour 2020-21 Season

With the Korn Ferry Tour forming a combined 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2021 Veritex Bank Championship will be the 29th tournament (of 43) of the 2020-21 regular season. Twenty-five PGA TOUR cards will be awarded to the top-25 players in the Korn Ferry Tour standings following the conclusion of the regular season in August (following the Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Aetna). Additionally, 25 PGA TOUR cards will be awarded at the conclusion of the three-event Korn Ferry Tour Finals in August/September.
