**Extended Forecast** – The cold front will move through north Texas tonight. Instability will be decreasing, however some showers/T-storms can't be ruled out as it passes through DFW. Sunny and even warmer conditions are expected on Sunday. Southerly winds could gust around 20 mph by the afternoon.
