Extended Forecast – The Friday forecast remains difficult and details may remain uncertain until Friday morning. With a warm and humid airmass in place, scattered showers/T-storms are likely to develop after 10-11am across NE Texas. Much of this activity may favor areas east of DFW during the afternoon. The other concern would be the potential for T-storms to develop along the dryline after 3-4pm but confidence in this is low. The threat for precipitation eventually ends Friday evening with dry, sunny, and mild conditions this weekend. Winds will be elevated at times through Sunday with gusts occasionally exceeding 20 mph.
