Things to Know

- Adam Hadwin holds his second PGA TOUR 36-hole lead/co-lead; 1-for-1 to date converting to victory
- Following a season-best T5 finish in last week’s Barbasol Championship, Ryan Armour holds his fifth 36-hole lead/co-lead (1-for-4 to date)
- Bo Hoag records lowest 36-hole score of his PGA TOUR career (133), two days before his 33rd birthday
- 18-hole co-leader Rickie Fowler sits five shots back
- World No. 2 Dustin Johnson misses the cut after rounds of 70-72

- 8 Second-round leaders/co-leaders to win on PGA TOUR in 2020-21 (most recent: Phil Mickelson/PGA Championship)
- 1 Second-round leader/co-leader to win the 3M Open (2020/Michael Thompson)

Adam Hadwin (T1/-10)

- Second 36-hole lead/co-lead of his PGA TOUR career, 1-for-1 to date (2017 Valspar Championship)
- Only bogey through 36 holes came at the par-4 seventh hole in round one
- Finished fourth at the 2019 3M Open, his only prior start at the event
- Comes off missed cuts in his last three starts
- Two top-8 finishes this season (T8/The Honda Classic, T8/Charles Schwab Challenge)
- In search of his second PGA TOUR victory (2017 Valspar Championship)
- Currently No. 120 in FedExCup, has advanced to the Playoffs each season since joining the TOUR in 2015

Ryan Armour (T1/-10)

- Following a season-best T5 finish in last week's Barbasol Championship, shares the lead through 36 holes
- Marks fifth time with 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (most recent: 2020 Bermuda Championship/T8); 1-for-4 to date
- Making third start at 3M Open (T42/2019, MC/2020)
- Ohio native seeks his second career TOUR victory in his 210th start; won the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship
- 44-year-old looks to become the seventh different winner 40 years of age or older this season (Stewart Cink/2, Sergio Garcia, Brian Gay, Matt Jones, Phil Mickelson, Lucas Glover)

Miscellaneous Notes

- 32-year-old **Bo Hoag** (T3/-9), who celebrates his birthday on Sunday (July 25th), recorded his lowest 36-hole score of his PGA TOUR career (133) after matching his previous best last week (134/Barbasol Championship)
- **Chez Reavie** (T3/-9) records rounds of 66-67; last time opened with 133 or better was 2021 John Deere Classic (131/T18)
- In his only prior start at the event, **Jhonattan Vegas** (T3/-9) missed the cut in 2020; seeks fourth top-10 finish of the season
- **Roger Sloan** (T3/-9) makes third consecutive start in the 3M Open with a T15 in 2019 his best showing
- Last week's first-, second- and third-hole leader at The Open Championship, **Louis Oosthuizen** (T19/-6) records back-to-back rounds of 3-under 68 to sit four shots back
- Defending champion **Michael Thompson** (T45) and 2019 champion **Matthew Wolff** (T36) seek to become the tournament's first repeat winner
- World No. 2 **Dustin Johnson** followed a 1-under 70 in round one with a 72 to miss his third cut of the season
- Former University of Minnesota standout and Minneapolis resident **Angus Flanagan** misses the cut after rounds of 72-82
- **Grayson Murray** (right knee) and **Vaughn Taylor** (lower back) withdrew during round two
