Things to Know

- Cameron Tringale posts bogey-free 5-under 66, nears first career TOUR title in his 307th start
- Only 54-hole leader/co-leader in last 12 TOUR events to convert for the win was Phil Mickelson (PGA Championship)
- Gary Woodland overcomes a double bogey at the first hole with birdies on five of his next six to post 4-under 67
- Maverick McNealy closes in on third top-5 finish of the season and fifth consecutive top-30 finish
- Pat Perez follows a bogey-free 6-under 65 in round two with a bogey-free 66 in round three
- Keith Mitchell becomes the fourth player since 2003 to begin a round with seven straight sub-par scores

Cameron Tringale (1st/-12)

- In addition to birdies at Nos. 1, 2 and 16, eagled the par-5 12th on his way to a bogey-free 5-under 66
- Marks second occasion to hold a 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2019 John Deere Classic/T16)
- The 54-hole leader has converted for the win on just one of the last 12 occasions on TOUR (Phil Mickelson/PGA Championship)
- On the strength of an 8-under 63 in round three last year, finished T3 at the 2020 3M Open

- Four of his 26 top-10 finishes have come in the 2020-21 season
- Three-time runner-up remains in search of his first career TOUR title in his 307th start this week; holds the distinction of having the most starts on TOUR without a win since 2009

Miscellaneous Notes

- Making his first start in the 3M Open, **Gary Woodland** (T2/-11) followed a double bogey at the first hole with birdies on five of his next six en route to a 4-under 67; seeks a fifth career TOUR title and first since the 2019 U.S. Open
- In his first 3M Open start, **Maverick McNealy** (T2/-11) made three birdies and no bogeys in bid for his first career TOUR title; two top-5 finishes this season: 2nd/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, T4/RBC Heritage; comes off top-30 finishes in each of his last four TOUR starts, highlighted by a T18 in his most recent start at the John Deere Classic
- Making his third start in the 3M Open, **Pat Perez** (T4/-10) has played his last 42 holes without a bogey; two bogeys this week ties his record for fewest through 54 holes in a PGA TOUR event
- With a win Sunday, Bo Hoag's (T16/-8) maiden TOUR title would come on his 33rd birthday
- **Keith Mitchell** (T16/-8) became the fourth player since 2003 to open a round with seven consecutive sub-par scores; he joins Joe Durant (R4/2005 The Honda Classic), Brandt Snedeker (R1/2007 Farmers Insurance Open) and Sebastian Munoz (R1/2020 THE NORTHERN TRUST); no player has started with more than seven
- **Rickie Fowler** (T29/-6) was 6-under through 10 holes before bogeys at 13 and 14 and a triple-bogey-8 at the par-5 18th resulted 1-under 70; his score at No. 18 marks the highest score of his career to finish a round; through three rounds, has played Nos. 1-12 in 11-under par and Nos. 13-18 in 5-over par
