



### Past Champion Analysis - Matthew Wolff (2019) & Michael Thompson (2020)

4th Start

Matthew Wolff earned his first career PGA TOUR victory in his fourth start on TOUR at the 3M Open, became the eighth player since 1970 to win in four or fewer starts and was the first player since Russell Henley (2013) to win in four or fewer starts on TOUR.

Wolff became the second youngest winner on TOUR since Jordan Spieth won the John

Deere Classic in 2013 at the age of 19.

Eagled 72<sup>nd</sup>

Matthew Wolff eagled the final hole in regulation and was the first player since Brooks Koepka to eagle the last hole in regulation (2018 THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES) and go onto win. Wolff's eagle on the last hole marked his second career eagle on TOUR

(WMPO Rd 2).

Collin Morikawa moved to No. 1 in the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 with his victory at The
