FedExCup Storylines

- 9** The Arnold Palmer Invitational champion has qualified for the TOUR Championship in nine of the 14 seasons of the FedExCup.
- 7th** Defending Arnold Palmer Invitational champion Tyrrell Hatton finished seventh in the final FedExCup standings last season, which was the eighth time the champion at Bay Hill Club & Lodge has finished the season inside the top 10 of the FedExCup.
- 9** Nine players in the field at the Arnold Palmer Invitational can overtake Patrick Cantlay for the top spot on the FedExCup with a win this week.
- 966** Marc Leishman's total FedExCup points earned at the Arnold Palmer Invitational, most of any player at this event since 2016. Leishman has finished seventh or better in three of his last four Arnold Palmer Invitational starts, along with five top-25 finishes in this time frame (2016-2020)
- 32.86** Average age of the current top 125 of the FedExCup standings.

Viktor Hovland

Two-time PGA TOUR winner Viktor Hovland has finished fifth or better in four of his last five TOUR starts (dating back to his win at the 2020 Mayakoba Golf Classic). Hovland is seeking his third career PGA TOUR win in his 40th career TOUR start.

Fast Facts on Viktor Hovland:

- 2nd** Moved to Second in the FedExCup standings with a T2 finish last week at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession, marking the highest Viktor Hovland has ranked in the FedExCup of his TOUR career.
- 4** Since 1990, four players (Tiger Woods/6, Collin Morikawa/4, Rory McIlroy/3 & Carlos Franco/3) have each won three or more times in their first 41 PGA TOUR starts, Hovland is set to make his 40th TOUR start this week.
- 3** Viktor Hovland has three top-five finishes this season when starting with a 70 or higher in the opening round, marking the most top-five finishes of any player in the 2020-21 season after opening with a 70 or higher in Round 1.

Defending Arnold Palmer Invitational champion Tyrrell Hatton is set to make his fifth start at this event and eighth TOUR start this season. Hatton currently ranks 66th in the FedExCup standings with two top 10s and four top-25 finishes in seven starts in the 2020-21 season.

Fast Facts on Tyrrell Hatton:

- 3** Played holes 17 and 18 at Bay Hill Club & Lodge over 3.5 strokes better than the field at this event in 2020. Only Tiger Woods (2003) had a better cumulative score to par on these two holes by a winner of the Arnold Palmer Invitational.
- 2.88** Hatton played the par 3s to a stroke average of 2.88 for the week compared to the field 3.21 average. Tyrrell Hatton made birdie or better on the par 3s 18.8% of the time, 12.8% more than the field average (6%).
- +6.17** Outperformed the field by +6.17 strokes in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green on the back 9 en route to victory, marking the best of an Arnold Palmer Invitational champion since 2004.

Rory McIlroy

18-time PGA TOUR winner, 2018 Arnold Palmer Invitational champion and two-time FedExCup champion Rory McIlroy is set to make his seventh start at this event.

Fast Facts on Rory McIlroy:

- 1st** Since 2015, Rory McIlroy has the best score to par (-52), the most birdies or better (112), the most Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green (+46.8), the most drives over 300 yards (162) and the best Scoring Average (69.8) of any player at the Arnold Palmer Invitational in this time frame.
- 162** Rory McIlroy has hit 162 total drives over 300 yards at Bay Hill Club & Lodge since his first start in 2015, 28 more than the next player (Jason Kokrak/134)
- +46.8** Since 2015, Rory McIlroy is over seven strokes better from tee to green at the Arnold Palmer Invitational than any other player. In this time frame, Rory McIlroy has gained 46.8 total strokes from tee to green at Bay Hill Club & Lodge.
