Today – Any shallow patches of fog are expected to burn off quickly after sunrise. Otherwise expect sunny to mostly sunny skies throughout the day with a high temperature near 77 degrees. Winds will start off light becoming northeasterly by mid-morning and turning east-northeasterly this afternoon.

Extended forecast – Isolated showers are expected to become possible after 4am Saturday ahead of a storm system set to move across Florida later in the day. Expect showers to gradually increase in coverage during the morning hours, becoming widespread and heavy at times in the afternoon. Rainfall of 0.50" – 0.75" will be possible between 1-6pm Saturday. Rain is expected to continue into Saturday evening before gradually becoming isolated overnight. Should any embedded thunderstorms develop (lightning probability 10-20%), they would likely occur after 11am-noon. Some isolated showers may linger through 3am Sunday before dry and windy conditions close out the weekend.
