- 1st** Bryson DeChambeau moved from Second to No. 1 in the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 with a T9 finish last week at the Wells Fargo Championship
- 20** Total weeks Bryson DeChambeau has ranked No. 1 in the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 in his career, third-most over the last five PGA TOUR seasons (Justin Thomas/40, Dustin Johnson/28)
- 3** Three players are currently inside the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 with 12 weeks left in the FedExCup Regular season who were in the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 with 12 weeks remaining last season (*Justin Thomas, Cameron Smith & Hideki Matsuyama*)
- 4** Since 2009, four players outside the top-50 of the FedExCup finished the FedExCup Regular season inside the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10
- 5** Last season, five of the players inside the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 with 12 weeks left in the FedExCup Regular season finished the regular season inside the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10

Scottie Scheffler is set to make his third AT&T Byron Nelson with a T22 (2014) and T35 (2019) in his first two starts at this event. Scheffler is a combined 33 under in the Opening Round on TOUR this season, 18 strokes better than his cumulative 15-under par in Round 2.

2019 AT&T Byron Nelson champion Sung Kang is set to make his seventh start at this event. Kang has played 15 of his last 16 rounds par or better at the AT&T Byron Nelson. Currently 184th in the FedExCup standings, Sung Kang is seeking to get back to the FedExCup playoffs for the sixth consecutive season.

- 5** Has qualified for the FedExCup playoffs in each of the last five PGA TOUR seasons, finished a career best 45th the same year where he won the AT&T Byron Nelson.

Cameron Champ

Cameron Champ is set to make his 69th PGA TOUR start and AT&T Byron Nelson debut. The two-time PGA TOUR winner currently ranks 128th in the FedExCup standings and is seeking to make it to the FedExCup playoffs for the third consecutive season.

Fast Facts on Cameron Champ:

- 23** With two PGA TOUR wins, Cameron Champ is one of only 23 players who have multiple PGA TOUR Wins since the start of the 2018-19 PGA TOUR Season.
- +0.74/-1.439** Cameron Champ's advantage off the tee is being lost on his play from on and around the green. Champ gains +0.74 strokes per round off the tee and approach the green, however loses nearly a stroke and a half on and around the greens per round on TOUR.
- 25%/49%** Cameron Champ's sand save percentage compared to the TOUR average. One area of opportunity for Cameron Champ is bunker play, on 76 sand save opportunities Cameron Champ has successfully got up and down 19 times (25%) compared to the TOUR average of 49.4%.
