

Things to Know

- Sam Burns holds his PGA TOUR-leading fourth 54-hole lead/co-lead of the season
- Burns looks to become the third player with multiple victories this season (Bryson DeChambeau, Stewart Cink)
- K.H. Lee seeks first TOUR win in 80th career start after a bogey-free 5-under 67
- First-round co-leader Jordan Spieth sits T3 with Matt Kuchar, Charl Schwartzel and Alex Noren
- Due to the expectation of inclement weather, Sunday's final round will feature threesomes off tee Nos. 1 and 10 between 7-9:01 a.m. CT

Sam Burns (1st/-20)

- At 20-under 196, cards career-low 54-hole tournament score (previous: 199/2021 Valspar Championship) and carries a one-stroke lead into the final round
- Fourth 54-hole lead/co-lead of the season (most of any player): T7/Vivint Houston Open, 3rd/The Genesis Invitational, 1st/Valspar Championship, TBD/AT&T Byron Nelson); 1-for-3 to date converting to victory
- Follows a career-low 10-under 62, with a third round 3-under 69



- Trying to become the third player with multiple titles during the 2020-21 season, joining Bryson DeChambeau (U.S. Open, Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard) and Stewart Cink (Fortinet Championship, RBC Heritage)
- Making his first start since picking up his first PGA TOUR victory at the Valspar Championship, where the 24-year-old become the second-youngest winner of that event (Jordan Spieth/2015/21 years, 7 months, 16 days)
- With a victory this week, would become the first player since Camilo Villegas in 2008 (BMW Championship, TOUR Championship) to win his first two PGA TOUR titles in consecutive starts
- Making second start at AT&T Byron Nelson (T72/2019)

K.H. Lee (2nd/-19)

- Follows up back-to-back scores of 65 with a bogey-free 5-under 67; trails Sam Burns by one stroke
- Would become the third Korean-born player to win the AT&T Byron Nelson (Sangmoon Bae/2013, Sung Kang/2019)
- Born in Seoul, South Korea, is one of eight PGA TOUR members from South Korea
- Makes second start in the AT&T Byron Nelson (2019/T72)
- Seeks first TOUR win in 80th career start; career-best finish came at 2021 Waste Management Phoenix Open (T2)

Jordan Spieth (T3/-17)

- After opening rounds of 63-70, 18-hole co-leader offset two bogeys with six birdies and an eagle on hole No. 18, his second of the week on the hole
- Best of nine previous starts at the AT&T Byron Nelson is a T16 from his first start of 2010
- Dallas native is making second start since claiming his 12th and most recent victory at the Valero Texas Open in San Antonio
- Finished inside the top-5 in five of his last seven stroke-play events (T9 at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play)

Additional Player Notes

- Charl Schwartzel (T3/-17) posted a 6-under 66 and is seeking his third PGA TOUR victory and first since 2016 Valspar Championship
- Matt Kuchar (T3/-17) seeks 10th PGA TOUR title and first since the 2019 Sony Open in Hawaii (a span of 854 days); best finish in 11 previous AT&T Byron Nelson starts was solo third in 2016
- Alex Noren (T3/-17) in hunt to notch the 12th win by an international player at the AT&T Byron Nelson since 2000
- After beginning the third round at the cutline (T54), Harris English and Scott Stallings posted the day's low score of 9-under 63 to sit in a tie for ninth
- Defending champion Sung Kang is T56 at 8-under 208
- Dallas resident Will Zalatoris (T34) seeks seventh top-10 finish this season in his third AT&T Byron Nelson start
