**Extended Forecast** – There is a low threat for showers/T-storms this evening and again late tonight. The threat for T-storms will increase substantially on Sunday as an upper level disturbance interacts with a warm and unstable airmass. The timing of the worst impacts remains rather uncertain, although latest model guidance is indicating the late morning (after 10am) into the afternoon hours would have the worst weather. Rainfall amounts could become problematic, and the current forecast may be too conservative. The potential for showers/T-storms likely continues into early next week across DFW.
