Today – Showers/T storms could develop at anytime during the day, however the period between 10am 4pm is favored for the most widespread and persistent activity. The severe weather threat is low, however heavy rain is a concern given ample moisture levels and very slow storm motion. A diminishing trend in precipitation coverage is expected after 4pm with dry conditions possible this evening. Most likely rainfall: 0.50-1.00” with localized amounts over 1.50”. **Sunrise: 6:26am / Sunset: 8:20pm**

This could produce gusty winds and heavy rain as it moves through. If this complex develops and affects the area during the morning, then mainly dry conditions would occur during the afternoon. Rainfall: 0.50-1.00” with locally higher amounts possible. **Sunrise: 6:25am / Sunset: 8:20pm**
