- 28** Since 2013, Jason Day has made 28 putts from over 10 feet at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am on the host course (Pebble Beach Golf Links), most of any player in this time frame.
- 64%** Si Woo Kim has shot 68 or better in 64% of his last 14 rounds on the PGA TOUR (9 times) compared to 25% in his first 24 rounds this season (6). Kim is a combined 44-under par in his last 14 rounds, 14 strokes better than his previous 24 rounds this season.
- 3rd** Patrick Cantlay currently ranks third in the FedExCup standings and has ranked inside the top five of the FedExCup in 10 weeks this season. Patrick Cantlay had only ranked inside the top five in five weeks prior to this season.
- 16** Jordan Spieth has the most rounds of 68 or better at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am of any player since 2013 (16).
- 8** Defending champion Nick Taylor has the most eagles of any player at this event since 2017 (8).
- 3** This season, Rickie Fowler has improved his round two score by six or more strokes in three events, marking his 25th, 26th and 27th time in his career to improve his score in round two by 6+ strokes. The most events Rickie Fowler has improved his round two score by 6+ strokes in a season is four (2013 & 2019-20).
- 2** Max Homa was one of two players last season who recorded top-15 finishes in both the 2020 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am & The Genesis Invitational (Joel Dahmen).
- 27** Phil Mickelson has 14 more rounds of five under or better than any other player at this event since 1997 (27). Mickelson has posted more rounds of five under or better at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am than any other PGA TOUR event.
- 69.83** Paul Casey has a 69.83 stroke average in his last 12 rounds at this event, 3.84 strokes better than in his first four rounds (73.67). Casey is 23 under in his last three AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am appearances, 33 total strokes better than his first two starts (+10).
- 7** Francesco Molinari has seven top-10 finishes when making his tournament debut on the PGA TOUR
- 2** Brandt Snedeker is the only player since 2013 to make birdie on the par-5 18th on multiple occasions when finding the rocks off the tee (left of the fairway). Snedeker made birdie from the rocks in both Round 1 of the 2019 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and the 2019 U.S. Open (*held at Pebble Beach GL*).
- 1** Stewart Cink is the only player to rank inside the top 30 and only player inside the top 10 of the FedExCup in all 17 weeks this season (*Currently 10th in standings*)

- 1** Nick Taylor won in wire-to-wire fashion at this event last season, marking the most recent player to win in this fashion on TOUR.
- 4** Four of the last nine winners have played the final round bogey-free at this event compared to three in first 28 (since 1983).
- 32** Since 1983, the winner of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am has been inside the top 10 of the leaderboard after 54 holes in 32 of 33 editions of this event (72-hole event). The only player to come from outside the top 10 after 54 holes and win this event since 1983 was Davis Love III (2001).
- 9** The winner of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am has ranked inside the top 10 for Greens in Regulation in each of the last nine years (since 2012)
- 23.5** Since 2015, the winners of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am have made an average of 23.5 birdies en route to victory at this event. Four of the last six have led in field in Total birdies for the week.

Course & Hole Statistics

- 6,816** At 6,816 yards (*scorecard*), Pebble Beach Golf Links played as the shortest course on TOUR last season.
- 272.9 yds** Pebble Beach Golf Links had the shortest Driving Distance (All Drives) of any course last season (272.9 yds)
- 19.51%** Pebble Beach Golf Links was one of four courses last season that the field did not hit more than 20% of the total drives over 300 yards. Last season, players hit 19.51% of drives over 300 yards for the week.
- 123** Dustin Johnson and J.B. Holmes are the only two players to hit more than 100 drives over 300 yards at Pebble Golf Links during this event. Dustin Johnson has hit 123 total drives over 300 yards at Pebble Beach Golf Links during this event.
- 18.94%** Pebble Beach Golf Links had the fifth lowest birdie or better percentage from inside 125 yards last season (18.94%)
- 4th / 5th** Players managed to get up and down from greenside bunkers 42.21% of the time on Pebble Beach Golf Links in 2020, marking the fourth lowest Sand Save percentage at this course since 1992 and the fifth lowest of any course on TOUR last season.

- 3rd** Nick Taylor was the just the third player to shoot 63 or better in the opening round at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (2005 Phil Mickelson, 62 & 2011 D.A. Points, 63).

- 4** Rickie Fowler has struggled recently, shooting over par in four of his last five rounds on TOUR entering this week.
