### Things to Know

- James Hahn equals the best score in Barbasol Championship history with a 12-under 60
- Hahn tops his previous-low round and the current-course record by two strokes
- J.T. Poston holds his second 54-hole lead/co-lead of his PGA TOUR career
- Current bogey-free streaks: Poston (41 holes), Luke List (36 holes), Hahn (32 holes)
- Defending champion Jim Herman birdies five out of the last seven holes and trails by five
- Preferred lies have been utilized for the first three rounds

- 3 Third-round leader/co-leader to win the Barbasol Championship (Scott Piercy/2015, Troy Merritt/2018, Jim Herman/2019)

### J. T. Poston (1st/-19)

- Holds his second 54-hole lead/co-lead of his PGA TOUR career (2020 Sanderson Farms Championship/3<sup>rd</sup>)
- Including matching back-to-back rounds of 6-under 66, has now played his last 41 holes without a bogey
- Lone bogey through 54 holes came during his opening round on the par-4 13<sup>th</sup> hole
- Has advanced to the weekend in all four Barbasol Championship appearances (T42/2017, 5th/2018, T29/2019, TBD/2021)

- Owns five top-25s in 25 starts this season, led by a third-place finish at the Sanderson Farms Championship
- Lone PGA TOUR win came at the 2019 Wyndham Championship, going bogey-free en route to victory

#### James Hahn (T3/-17)

- Equals the best score in Barbasol Championship history with a 12-under 60
- Marks the 41<sup>st</sup> 60 in PGA TOUR history (there have been 12 sub-60 scores)
- Posts the TOUR's lowest score since the second round of THE NORTHERN TRUST in 2020 (Scottie Scheffler/59, Dustin Johnson/60)
- His previous-low score on TOUR was 62 (set three times; most recently at the 2018 Sony Open in Hawaii/R4)
- Has a career-best four eagles this week, including Nos. 5 and 15 in the third round
- Third-round 60 included 22 putts, equaling his career-best total in a round
- Tops the Keene Trace Golf Club (Champions) 18-hole record by two strokes
- Seeks his third PGA TOUR win in his 206<sup>th</sup> start (2015 The Genesis Invitational, 2016 Wells Fargo Championship)
- This week snaps a streak of eight missed cuts (previous made cut: 2021 THE PLAYERS Championship/T41)

#### Additional Player Notes

- Coming off a T4 finish at last week's John Deere Classic, **Luke List** (2<sup>nd</sup>) trails by one as he seeks his first PGA TOUR victory in his 194<sup>th</sup> start
- Making tournament debut and entering the week with three-consecutive missed cuts, **Joseph Bramlett** (T3) trails by two; in 71 TOUR starts, holds two top-10s (2021 AT&T Byron Nelson/ T7, 2020 Puerto Rico Open/T9)
- **Seamus Power** (T5) enters the final round poised for his sixth-consecutive top-20 finish and first victory in his 106<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR start
- Having entered the week with four straight missed cuts, **David Lingmerth** (T5) in striking distance for his second PGA TOUR victory in 181 starts (2015 the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday)
- **Sam Ryder** (T18) sees bogey-free streak this week end on the 54<sup>th</sup> hole; suffers double bogey on par-4 18<sup>th</sup>
- Defending champion **Jim Herman** (T12) birdies five of his last seven holes en route to a 7-under 65 in attempt to become event's first repeat winner
- Lexington native and Morehead State University graduate **Josh Teater** (T24) sits eight strokes back
