Things to Know

- Seamus Power defeats J.T. Poston in a six-hole playoff to pick up his first PGA TOUR victory
- Power becomes the eighth first-time winner of the season
- Playoff records: Power (1-0), Poston (0-1)
- Poston falls to 0-for-2 in his career when holding the 54-hole lead/co-lead
- Defending champion Jim Herman finishes T20

Seamus Power (1st/-21)

- Earned his first career PGA TOUR win in his 106th TOUR start at 34 years, 4 months, 14 days
- Entered the final round trailing J.T. Poston by three-strokes; closed with a 5-under 67 to earn a spot in the playoff
- Wins in his first playoff appearance on the PGA TOUR; was the 10th playoff of the season on TOUR
- Win comes in his fourth start at Barbasol Championship (T18/2017, T34/2018, T53/2019, 1st/2021)
- Collects 300 FedExCup points and projected to move to No. 69 in the FedExCup standings; took 376 points to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs in 2019 (last full regular season), 659 for BMW Championship and 1254 for the TOUR Championship
- Becomes the eighth first-time winner this season, joining Jason Kokrak, Carlos Ortiz, Joel Dahmen, Sam Burns, K.H. Lee, Garrick Higgo, Cam Davis
- Previous-best finish on TOUR was T5 (2018 Corales Puntacana, 2019 Zurich Classic of New Orleans)

J. T. Poston (2nd/-21)

- Falls to 0-for-2 in his career when holding the 54-hole lead/co-lead this season (3rd/2020 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2nd/Barbasol Championship)
- Most recent top-10 result before Sunday's runner-up finish was third-place finish at the 2020 Sanderson Farms Championship
- Was in search of his second PGA TOUR win (2019 Wyndham Championship)

Additional Player Notes

- **James Hahn** (T5/-19) follows a career-best and tournament-record-tying 12-under 60 with a 70 for first top-5 since the 2020 Shriners Children's Open
- Sam Ryder (T3/-20) notched his fourth top-10 of the season after posting the most bogey-free rounds on the week (3)
- In his tournament debut, India native **Anirban Lahiri** (T3/-20) finished just one stroke back in search of his first PGA TOUR title
- Coming off a T6 in last year's Barbasol Championship, Lexington native and Morehead State University graduate Josh Teater (T15/-17) used a final-round 6-under 66 to claim his best finish since the 2020 Puerto Rico Open (2nd)
- Defending champion Jim Herman finished T20 (-15) in bid to become event's first repeat winner
