Today – Areas of showers/T-storms are expected to develop around the area today, especially during the afternoon/evening. It appears the period between 11am-5pm and after 8pm are the most likely periods for development. Heavy rain will be a concern in any activity that develops. Temperatures will climb into the middle 80s with a breezy southwest wind developing. Wind gusts around 20 mph are expected. Most likely rainfall: 0.25-0.50”; with locally higher amounts in T-storms. **Sunrise: 6:28am / Sunset: 9:00pm**

Extended Forecast – A cold front will push towards the Ohio Valley tonight with periods of showers/T-storms becoming more likely across the Lexington area. Heavy rain is a concern as several rounds of activity are possible. Additional scattered showers and T-storms are possible on Saturday, but coverage and severity of activity will be dependent on the location of the front and cloud cover. Its becoming increasingly likely the cold front settles to our south by Sunday morning however it appears some areas of precipitation will linger behind the front.
