**Today** – A cold front is approaching from the west this morning with a line of showers and T-storms expected to move through between 9am-12pm. Rain chances should diminish by early this afternoon with dry conditions favored the rest of the day. Southwest winds will be in place this morning before switching to the northwest this afternoon. Gusts over 15 mph are possible before noon as well. Most likely rainfall: Up to 0.25" with locally higher amounts in T-storms. **Sunrise: 6:28am / Sunset: 9:00pm**

**Extended Forecast** – The threat for an isolated shower/T-storm could linger into this evening, otherwise dry weather is expected overnight. A slight chance for a shower/T-storm will remain in the forecast for Sunday, however much of the day likely remains dry. Dry and comfortable conditions are expected on Monday. Temperatures in the lower 80s will occur Sunday/Monday with winds out of the northeast.
