Extended Forecast – A slow moving cold front will begin to advance towards the Ohio Valley on Friday and then slowly shift southward through Kentucky this weekend. Timing out the individual waves of precipitation during this period remains challenging, however it appears the greatest threat for shower/T-storms will be Friday night and Saturday. Depending on where the front settles, most of the precipitation on Sunday could remain to our south. Southwest winds will be in place for much of the period before switching northwest late Sunday. Gusts near 20 mph are possible on Friday.
