Things to Know

- Emiliano Grillo holds third 36-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR; seeks third top-20 finish at the tournament
- In his 114th career start on TOUR, Adam Schenk posts 19 points, tied for most of any player in the second round (Ben Taylor)
- 2018 tournament winner Andrew Putnam remains the only player in the field bogey-free through 36 holes
- Three of eight past Barracuda Championship winners in the field sit inside the top 10
- Notables to miss the cut include Matt Kuchar, Ryan Moore, Brandt Snedeker, Pdraig Harrington and John Daly

Scoring

The Barracuda Championship is employing the Modified Stableford scoring format, the first PGA TOUR event to use the format since The International in 2006. Players are allocated points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole with the goal of achieving the highest overall score.

Emiliano Grillo (+29/1st)

- Opened the second round going birdie-eagle-birdie and finished bogey-free to reach +29 points
- Marks third 36-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR (2020 Puerto Rico Open/T3, 2020 World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba/T8)
- Seeks third top-20 finish at the tournament (T18/2019, T9/2020)
- Ranks No. 42 in the FedExCup standings, highest ranked player in the field
- Owns a career-best 11 top-25s in 27 starts this season, including runner-up at RBC Heritage
- Carded 19 top-10s since his lone win on the PGA TOUR (2015 Fortinet Championship)
- Advanced to the FedExCup Playoffs in all five seasons as a PGA TOUR member (2016-2020)

Additional Notes

- **Adam Schenk** (+27/2nd) makes third appearance at Barracuda Championship (MC/2018, T12/2020); sits No. 113 in FedExCup while seeking to advance to the FedExCup Playoffs for the third consecutive season
- 18-hole leader **Joel Dahmen** (+26/3rd) leads the field in birdies (15); with a win would become the seventh multiple winner of the season (2021 Corales Puntacana Championship)
- In his tournament debut, **Scott Harrington** (+25/T4) seeks first PGA TOUR victory in 55th start; the last five winners of the Barracuda Championship have been first-time winners (TOUR's longest active streak)
- Five of eight past Barracuda Championship in the field made the cut: **Andrew Putnam** (+25/T4), **Scott Piercy** (+25/T4), **Richy Werenski** (+19/T10), **Gary Woodland** (+16/T22), **Greg Chalmers** (+15/T28)
- Playing on a sponsor exemption, **John Pak** (+22/T8) advances to the weekend for the first time in his sixth PGA TOUR start since turning professional after standout college career at Florida State
- Two of the three 2020 Olympians in the field advanced to the weekend: **Thomas Pieters** (T45), **Mito Pereira** (T59), **Rafael Campos** (MC)
- Three players in this week's field of the nine players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in every season since the inception of the FedExCup (2007-present) missed the cut; **Brandt Snedeker** (currently 91st in FedExCup), **Matt Kuchar** (currently 120th in the FedExCup), **Ryan Moore** (currently 140th in the FedExCup)
- **Vaughn Taylor** withdrew prior to round two with a rib injury
- **Ricky Barnes** was disqualified for signing an incorrect scorecard during the second round
