Today – Smoke from wildfires across northern California will continue to spread across the Tahoe Basin and likely lead to periods of opaque sunshine throughout the day. The other concern will be air quality, especially once daytime mixing commences. Light winds are expected through the early afternoon before a weak westerly wind (generally under 10 mph) develops after 2pm. **Current AQI Values: 150-200 (Unhealthy)**. These values may climb even higher during the day. **Sunrise: 6:04am / Sunset: 8:08pm**

Extended Forecast – Wildfire smoke will remain trapped over the Tahoe Basin tonight with some gradual improvement possible Saturday as upper-level winds become southerly. A more substantial improvement is expected on Sunday as the next dry cold front approaches. Air quality levels may drop into the unhealthy category at times (AQI > 150). High temperatures will be in the 80s through Monday with the typical westerly winds developing during the afternoon. Gusts around 20 mph will be possible.
