


## 10am Weather Forecast

**Today** – Smoke remains trapped in the Truckee River Valley but has become much shallower in nature. This has allowed air quality to improve tremendously, especially compared to 12-18 hours ago. With less smoke noted aloft and the stronger winds expected today, air quality values should hold steady or even improve this afternoon. Wind gusts of 15-20 mph possible after 2pm. **Current AQI Values: 150-200 (Unhealthy).** \*These values are unlikely to exceed 250 today. **Sunrise: 6:05am / Sunset: 8:06pm**

**Extended Forecast** – Smoke will likely remain trapped in the Truckee River Valley tonight but air quality should begin to improve on Sunday as upper-level winds strength and become southwesterly. This likely pushes the denser smoke into northern California & Nevada. Surface winds will also be stronger on Sunday with gusts potentially exceeding 20 mph during the afternoon. A high in the middle 80s is expected Sunday.
