Today – A thicker layer of elevated smoke is moving through the Sierras this morning but has not impacted air quality. As winds in the upper levels and near the surface increase by mid-day, dispersion of the smoke and improving air quality become more likely this afternoon. Westerly winds will be more pronounced today with gusts around 20 mph becoming possible this afternoon. A high in the middle 80s is expected. **Current AQI Values: ~150 (Unhealthy).** **Sunrise: 6:06am / Sunset: 8:05pm**

Tomorrow – Elevated areas of smoke will likely linger over the Sierras on Monday resulting in hazy sunshine throughout the day. Any thicker, near surface smoke from the Dixie Fire, should remain north of Truckee given the projected wind direction. Temperatures during the day will climb into the middle 80s with a west/southwest wind in place during the afternoon. **Sunrise: 6:07am / Sunset: 8:03pm**
