**Brendon Todd**

Defending champion Brendon Todd is set to make his 200<sup>th</sup> career PGA TOUR start. Todd was one of three players last season to record three top-five finishes in the fall events and one of six players since the start of the 2013-14 season to record three top-fives in the fall events of the wrap-around schedule.

**Fast Facts on Brendon Todd:**

- 2** Won the 2019 Bermuda Championship and 2019 Mayakoba Golf Classic, marking the first player to win multiple times in a season during the fall events of TOUR since the start of the wrap-around schedule (2013-14 season).
- 4<sup>th</sup>** Ranked fourth in Driving Accuracy, hitting 69.64% of the fairways en route to victory at this event last season. Todd ranked inside the top-four in Driving Accuracy in nine events last season, four more than the next player.
- 7** Todd was the third winner in the ShotLink era to record seven consecutive birdies in the final round en route to victory (*Kevin Streelman/2014 Travelers Championship & Fabian Gomez/2016 Sony Open in Hawaii*).
- 17** 17-under par on the Front 9 at Port Royal GC, three strokes better than the next best player.

**Stewart Cink**

Seven-time PGA TOUR winner Stewart Cink is one of two players in the field with more than six wins on TOUR (Fred Funk/8). Cink is set to make his Bermuda Championship debut and his 599<sup>th</sup> career TOUR start.

**Fast Facts on Stewart Cink:**

- 47** With his victory at the season opening Safeway Open, Cink became the oldest player to start a PGA TOUR season with a victory since 1970.
- 5<sup>th</sup> / 562** Highest ranked player in the FedExCup standings in the field this week. Cink currently ranks fifth in the FedExCup with one win (Safeway Open) and a T12 (Sanderson Farms Championship) in three starts so far this season. Cink has earned 562 FedExCup points in his first three starts this season on the strength of his season opening win at the Safeway Open, marking just his third season since 2009 to earn more than 100 FedExCup points in his first three starts in a season.
- 4** has four rounds of 65 or better in 12 rounds this season, only Patrick Cantlay (5) has more rounds of 65 or better in the 2020-21 PGA TOUR season.

2009 PLAYERS champion Henrik Stenson is set to make his 212<sup>th</sup> career PGA TOUR start at the 2020 Bermuda Championship.

**Fast Facts on Henrik Stenson:**

- 2** One of two PLAYERS champions (Fred Funk) and one of two FedExCup champions in the field this week (Bill Haas)
- 70.66%** has the best Greens in Regulation percentage of any player since the start of the 2013 PGA TOUR season (min 100 Rds). In this time frame, Henrik Stenson has hit 70.66% of the greens in regulation on TOUR.
- 3** Henrik Stenson is one of five players who have led the PGA TOUR for Greens in Regulation percentage in three or more seasons since 1980, only Tiger Woods has led in Greens in Regulation more than Stenson (*Seasons 1<sup>st</sup> in GIR: 2013, 2014-15 & 2017-18*)
