Today — An approaching upper-level disturbance will allow numerous showers/T-storms to develop across the region this afternoon. The period of most concern will be between 4-9pm. Periods of heavy rain and gusty winds are possible with this activity. The threat for precipitation should diminish overnight with dry conditions favored after midnight. Peak Heat Index: 94-98F. Most likely rainfall: 0.50-1.00"; with locally upwards of 2". **Sunrise: 6:29am / Sunset: 7:47pm**

Extended Forecast – A lower threat for showers/T-storms should linger into Saturday, however with the front shifting south of Baltimore, most of the day could end up dry. Most of Sunday likely stays dry as well with just a low threat for an afternoon shower/T-storm. Temperatures will be slightly cooler this weekend, with highs in the middle to upper 80s. Northerly winds are also expected, especially on Saturday. A higher threat for showers/T-storms should develop on Monday as the next front arrives.
