- **27.6%** The last six Charles Schwab Challenge champions make 27.6% of their putts from outside 10 feet (74 of 268), 11.3% better than the field average in this time frame (16.3%). Winners make an average of 12 putts from outside 10 feet in this time frame while the field makes an average of 5 putts at Colonial CC.
- **7th** Each of the last six Charles Schwab Challenge champions have been seventh or better after 54-holes.
