Today – One more day of elevated instability and moisture levels, however steering flow favors the main area of daytime shower/T-storm development farther inland compared to the last couple days. The sea breeze will begin to push inland after 9-10am with the best chances for any precipitation at the course between 10am-2pm. Temperatures will climb near 90 degrees by this afternoon. Rainfall: Less than 0.10" but locally higher in T-storms. **Sunrise: 6:24am / Sunset: 6:28pm**

Extended Forecast – Low level easterly flow will become reestablished over the region Friday and continuing through the weekend. This will result in slightly lower instability/moisture levels and a diminished threat for T-storms. Overall, this pattern favors periodic shower chances, mainly during the overnight and morning hours, with daily rain chances no higher than 30%. Winds will generally be out of the east to east-northeast at 6-12 mph. The strongest winds will be found near the coast with some gusts to around 15 mph possible.
