**Today** – An isolated passing shower or two will be possible through mid-morning. These ocean showers may produce briefly moderate intensity rainfall. Dry conditions are largely anticipated thereafter and through the afternoon, with just a slim chance for a late-day ocean shower from activity that develops over western Puerto Rico. East-northeasterly winds will be sustained between 14-20 mph with gusts up to 25 mph – strongest along the ocean. The temperature is forecast to reach a high near 85 degrees.

**Extended forecast** – Expecting a drier and more stable atmosphere on Saturday, with just an isolated risk for a passing morning shower in the trade winds. Dry conditions are anticipated Sunday morning, but an increase in moisture Sunday afternoon could lead to a few showers streaming in off the ocean after 2pm. A moderate to briefly heavy shower cannot be ruled out Sunday afternoon. East-northeasterly winds will remain elevated through the weekend, sustained between 14-22 mph with gusts of 23-26 mph – strongest along the ocean-facing holes.
