Things to Know

- Eight-time PGA TOUR winner Patrick Reed opens with 64, tying his second-lowest first-round score on TOUR
- Reed has converted three of his previous five 18-hole leads/co-leads on TOUR to victory
- Alex Noren holds a share of the lead after tying his career-low round on TOUR (64)
- Noren earned his career-best PGA TOUR result at the 2018 Farmers Insurance Open, losing in a playoff to Jason Day
- The last first-round leader/co-leader to win the Farmers Insurance Open was George Burns in 1987
- Of the 15 players that shot 66-or-better, only Peter Malnati (66) and Ryan Palmer (66) did so on the South Course

Patrick Reed (T1/-8) - NC

• Ties the second-lowest first-round score of his PGA TOUR career (lowest: 63/2014 The American Express; went on to win wire-to-wire)

- Sixth 18-hole lead/co-lead of PGA TOUR career; has converted three of the previous five to victory (Won/2014 The American Express, Won/2014 World Golf Championships-Mexico Championship, 2nd/2016 Sentry Tournament of Champions, Won/2016 THE NORTHERN TRUST, T7/2018 WGC-HSBC Champions)
- Three consecutive top-25s at the Farmers Insurance Open, highlighted by a T6 in 2020
- Best result in five starts on the season: T10/Masters Tournament
- Eight-time PGA TOUR winner (most recent: 2020 WGC-Mexico Championship)

Alex Noren (T1/-8) - NC

- Ties career-low round on the PGA TOUR; previous 64s: 2018 BMW Championship (R1), 2020 THE NORTHERN TRUST (R3)
- Third 18-hole lead/co-lead of PGA TOUR career; did not convert either of the previous two to victory (3rd/2018 The Honda Classic, T17/2018 THE PLAYERS Championship)
- Lost in a playoff at the 2018 Farmers Insurance Open to Jason Day, his career-best result in 94 starts on the PGA TOUR; missed the cut in his only other prior appearance (2019)
- Best result in seven starts on the season: T17 (twice: U.S. Open, ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP @ SHERWOOD)
- 10-time winner on the European Tour (most recent: 2018 Open de France)

Scottie Scheffler (3rd/-7) – NC

- Missed the cut in his only prior appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open (2020)
- In search of first career PGA TOUR victory; best result in 42 prior starts on TOUR: solo-third (2020 The American Express)
- Reigning PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year; finished the 2019-20 season No. 5 in the FedExCup standings

Additional Player Notes

- 2019 U.S. Open champion **Gary Woodland** (NC) is one of 12 players at T4 after a first-round 66; Woodland has two top-10s in 11 prior starts at the event (T10/2014, T9/2019)
- 50-year-old **K.J. Choi** (NC) opens with a 6-under 66 to stand T4; Choi is last in the field in Driving Distance averaging 258.5 yards, more than 10 yards behind the next-lowest average in the field (269.0 yards/Denny McCarthy, Tim Wilkinson)
- Of the 15 players that shot 66-or-better, only Peter Malnati (66) and Ryan Palmer (66) did so on the South Course
- Rory McIlroy (-4/SC) has two consecutive top-fives at the event (T5/2019, T3/2020)
- 2017 Farmers Insurance Open winner **Jon Rahm**, who entered the week as the highest-ranked player in the field at No. 2 in the Official World Golf Ranking, shot a 3-under 69 on the South Course (T32)
- Three-time Farmers Insurance Open winner Phil Mickelson (NC) opens with a 1-under 71 to stand T69
- For the second consecutive round at the Farmers Insurance Open, **Richy Werenski** (-3/T32) recorded a hole-in-one (No. 3/SC); Werenski made a hole-in-one in the final round in 2020 (No. 8/SC)
