Second-Round Notes - Friday, January 29, 2021

Weather: After an estimated 0.90 inches of rain fell Thursday night, it was sunny early with rain and hail later in the day. High of 59. Wind WSW 12-18 mph, gusting to 25 mph. Preferred lies were in use during the second round. Due to the inclement weather, play was suspended at 3:23 p.m. PT and resumed at 4:12 p.m., a delay of 49 minutes.

36-hole cut: 79 players at 1-under 143 from a field of 155 professionals and one amateur.

Things to Know

- Norway's Viktor Hovland in position to win for the second time in last three PGA TOUR starts
- Victory by Hovland would mark the fifth consecutive international winner at Farmers Insurance Open
- Hovland seeks to become third consecutive player to win this event after starting on the North Course
- Top seven players on the leaderboard are all PGA TOUR winners
- Phil Mickelson makes the cut on the number with birdie-birdie finish on South Course
- Brooks Koepka misses the cut in three consecutive starts for first time in his PGA TOUR career
- Four of eight past Farmers Insurance Open in the field advanced to the weekend

Viktor Hovland (1st/-9) - SC

- Mixes eight birdies with one bogey (No. 15) for Friday's low round on the South Course
- Holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for second time on PGA TOUR (Won/2020 Puerto Rico Open)
- Missed cut (73-72) in 2019 in only previous start at this event
- Searching for third PGA TOUR win in 37th career start; 2020 Puerto Rico Open, 2020 Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN
- Ranks No. 1 in Strokes Gained: Tee To Green (6.205) and Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (4.703)
- With a win, would join Ben Crane (2010), Justin Rose (2019) and Marc Leishman (2020) as only players since 2010 to have won after beginning the week on the North Course
- Seeks to become the fifth consecutive international champion at Farmers Insurance Open; five of the last six champions have been international players (2020/Marc Leishman/Australia, 2019/Justin Rose/England, 2018/Jason Day/Australia, 2017/Jon Rahm/Spain); prior to 2015, the last international winner of the Farmers Insurance Open was Spain's Jose Maria Olazabal in 2002

Jon Rahm (T2/-8) - NC

- Fifth appearance at this event (Won/2017, T29/2018, T5/2019, 2nd/2020)
- Owns 11 of 18 sub-70 scores at Farmers Insurance Open, including three of 65 or better
- Notched three top-10s in last three starts on TOUR (T2/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP @ SHERWOOD, T7/Masters Tournament, T7/Sentry Tournament of Champions)

Adam Scott (T2/-8) - SC

- Cards two eagles this week (No. 5/NC/R1, No. 6/SC/R2) after posting just one eagle in first five starts this season
- Seeks 15th TOUR title, his most recent coming at The Genesis Invitational in 2020
- Made the cut in all five prior starts this season, but has yet to post a top-20 finish
- Australian's only prior start at Farmers Insurance Open resulted in runner-up finish to Justin Rose in 2019

Tony Finau (T2/-8) - NC

- Seeks to continue his streak of top-25 finishes in six appearances at Farmers Insurance Open (T6/2020, T13/2019, T6/2018, T4/2017, T18/2016, T24/2015)
- Owns three top-10s in seven starts this season, including a fourth-place finish at last week's The American Express after holding a share of the 54-hole lead
- Carded 35 top-10s since his lone win on the PGA TOUR (2016 Puerto Rico Open)

Lanto Griffin (T2/-8) - SC

- Eagle at par-5 6th hole highlights a 2-under 70
- Making third start at Farmers Insurance Open (T12/2018, MC/2020)
- Lone top-10 in nine starts this season: T7/THE CJ CUP @ SHADOW CREEK
- 2019 Vivint Houston Open champion finished No. 18 in the FedExCup in the 2019-20 season

Ryan Palmer (T2/-8) - NC

- Held 36-hole lead/co-lead at this event in 2020 (T21) and 2018 (T2)
- Was part of a three-man playoff at 2018 Farmers Insurance Open, finishing T2 with Alex Noren
- 13 of 25 rounds at this event are under par, including both this week (66-70)

Additional Player Notes

- First-round co-leader **Patrick Reed** (T2/-8) makes four bogeys en route to even-par 72 after bogey-free 64 Thursday
- Will Gordon (T8/-7) has recorded five consecutive sub-par rounds (68-69-70-67-70) at this event after an opening-round 75 in 2020
- Robby Shelton (T8/-7) includes eight 3s on his card en route to an 8-under 64, his first sub-70 score at this event and the low round of the day
- **Peter Malnati** (T8/-7) advances to the weekend for the first time after missing the cut in four prior appearances at Farmers Insurance Open (2014, 2017, 2018, 2020)
- First-round co-leader Alex Noren (T11/-6) starts bogey-bogey en route to 2-over 74
- Rory McIlroy (T14/-5) has two consecutive top-fives at the event (T5/2019, T3/2020)
- San Diego native Xander Schauffele's (T40/-2) makes the cut for just the second time in six starts at this event

- Three-time Farmers Insurance Open winner **Phil Mickelson** (T54/-1) makes the cut on the number with a birdie-birdie finish (Nos. 17-18) on the South Course
- 14-stroke difference by **Scottie Scheffler** (65-79) ties second-largest margin in tournament history between rounds one and two (15 strokes/66-81/Gavin Coles/2003)
- After zero missed cuts and eight top-10s in 17 previous starts, Charles Howell III (+3) misses the cut in his 18th appearance at Farmers Insurance Open
- For the first time on the PGA TOUR (144 starts), **Brooks Koepka** (+4) misses the cut in three consecutive starts (2020 Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN, 2021 The American Express, 2021 Farmers Insurance Open)
- Reigning U.S. Amateur champion **Tyler Strafaci** (+8), the only amateur in the field, failed to advance to the weekend
- Matthew Wolff (hand injury) withdrew Thursday evening after the first round; Camilo Villegas (no reason given)
 and Martin Trainer (ankle) withdrew Friday morning before the start of round two; Fabian Gomez and Charley
 Hoffman withdrew during the second round
