Things to Know

- Carlos Ortiz posts low round of the day, 6-under 66, in bid to become season's first multiple winner
- Ortiz holds his first lead/co-lead after any round on the PGA TOUR
- 18-hole co-leader Patrick Reed in position to win for a fourth consecutive season and ninth time overall
- When holding at least a share of the 54-hole lead, Reed has converted for the win on five of seven occasions
- With a win Sunday, Reed would become the event's first American champion since Brandt Snedeker in 2016

Carlos Ortiz (T1/-10)

- After beginning the third round T21, offset a lone bogey with seven birdies, including four on his last six holes, to post the day's low score of 6-under 66
- Takes his first lead/co-lead after any round on the PGA TOUR
- Claimed his first career PGA TOUR win earlier this season at the Vivint Houston Open

- With a win Sunday, would become the season's first multiple winner
- In addition to his win in Texas, claimed a second top-10 finish in his next start at the Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN (T8)
- Comes into the week at No. 10 in the FedExCup and 54th in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Is making his 122nd career PGA TOUR start

Patrick Reed (T1/-10)

- Mixed birdies at Nos. 2, 4 and 9 with an eagle at the par-5 sixth hole to turn in 5-under 31, his lowest 9-hole score on the South Course in six Farmers Insurance Open starts
- With a 54-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR, has converted for the win on five of seven previous occasions
- 2-under 70 in round three marks his 11th consecutive score of par-or-better in the event
- Best finish in five previous Farmers Insurance Open starts was T6 in 2020
- Best result in five starts on the PGA TOUR this season is T10/Masters Tournament
- Seeks his ninth career PGA TOUR title and first since the 2020 World Golf Championships-Mexico Championship

Additional Player Notes

- En route to an even-par 72, **Adam Scott** (T3/-8) made five birdies, five bogeys, a double bogey (par-4 sixth) and an eagle (par-5 ninth); has eagled three par-5s this week (R1/5th/NC, R2/6th/SC, R3/9th/SC), tying his record for most in a PGA TOUR event
- Viktor Hovland (T3/-8) is searching for third PGA TOUR win in 37th career start (2020 Puerto Rico Open, 2020 Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN); with a win Sunday, would become the 2020-21 season's first multiple winner (2020 Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN)
- Making his fifth appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open, 2017 champion **Jon Rahm** (T3/-8) is 5-under on the par-3 holes through 54 holes; In his first four appearances in the event, played the par-3 holes in a collective 1-over par; seeks a fourth consecutive top-10 finish on the PGA TOUR (T2/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP @ SHERWOOD, T7/Masters Tournament, T7/Sentry Tournament of Champions)
- Making his fourth start in the Farmers Insurance Open (T49/2020, T40/2019, MC/2018), Louisiana native Sam Burns (T3/-8) is in position to claim his first career PGA TOUR victory in his 67th start
- Following T5 and T3 finishes in his first two Farmers Insurance Open starts in 2019 and 2020, respectively, **Rory McIlroy** sits T8 at 7-under 209
