Things to Know

- Patrick Reed earns his ninth PGA TOUR victory, winning the Farmers Insurance Open by five strokes
- Reed improves to 4-for-6 with the 18-hole lead/co-lead and 6-for-8 with the 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR
- Reed becomes the event’s first American champion since Brandt Snedeker in 2016
- San Diego native Xander Schauffele (T2) earns best finish in six starts at the event and seventh runner-up since his last win on TOUR
- Special Temporary Member Will Zalatoris (T7) collects fourth top-10 of the season

- Five-stroke margin of victory is largest of his career and largest on TOUR since Dustin Johnson won the 2020 Masters Tournament by five strokes
- Improves to 6-for-8 with the 54-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR

Additional Player Notes

- **Tony Finau** (T2) earns his second consecutive top-five (solo-fourth at last week's The American Express) and fourth top-10 of the season
- San Diego native **Xander Schauffele** (T2) collects best result in six starts at the Farmers Insurance Open; had a T25 and four missed cuts in five prior starts
- Schauffele now has seven runner-up finishes since his last victory (2019 Sentry Tournament of Champions)
- **Viktor Hovland** (T2) earns his first career runner-up on the PGA TOUR; Hovland was in search of his third PGA TOUR win and second in three starts
- **Henrik Norlander** (T2) was one of two players to record a sub-70 score in each of the final two rounds (68-69), joining Xander Schauffele (68-69); Norlander earns his best finish on TOUR since losing in a playoff at The RSM Classic in 2016
- **Ryan Palmer** (T2) earns his second runner-up at the Farmers Insurance Open and first since losing in a playoff in 2018
- Making his fifth appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open, 2017 champion **Jon Rahm** finishes T7, his fourth consecutive top-10 finish on the PGA TOUR (T2/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP @ SHERWOOD, T7/Masters Tournament, T7/Sentry Tournament of Champions, T7/Farmers Insurance Open)

- PGA TOUR Special Temporary Member **Will Zalatoris** earns his fourth top-10 of the season in his seventh start (T6/U.S. Open, T8/Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship, T5/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, T7/Farmers Insurance Open)
