- 33rd** Currently 33rd in the FedExCup standings marking his second-best rank with five weeks left before the FedExCup Playoffs of Si Woo Kim's PGA TOUR career. Last season, Kim was 147th in the standings with five weeks left and joined seven other players in the playoffs who were outside the top 125 at this point in 2020
- 25' 10"** C.T. Pan has improved his proximity on approaches from 150-175 yards in each of the last three seasons.
- 333** Sebastian Munoz is one of nine players with over 330 birdies made this season (333). Munoz made 340 total birdies last season, marking his most in a season on TOUR.
- 192** Zach Johnson is 192-under par at TPC Deere Run, best of any player at the John Deere Classic since 2000
- 69.93** Daniel Berger has the third best actual Scoring Average of any player this season (*min 37 rds*)
- 1st** Kevin Na leads the TOUR in SG: Around-the-Green, outperforming the TOUR by +0.621 strokes per round around the green. Na is on pace for one of his best SG: Around-the-Green performances in a single season.
- 1,268** Sungjae Im has made 1,268 birdies in the last three TOUR seasons, 269 more than any other player in this time frame (Niemann, 999). In his career Im has made 1,285 total birdies (*2017-18/17, 2018-19/480, 2019-20/390 & This Season/398*)
- 119th** Lahiri currently ranks 119th in the FedExCup standings and is one of 10 players who have improved their FedExCup position this season by 100 or more ranks than last season
- +47** Cam Davis moved from 81st to 34th in the FedExCup with his victory last week at the Rocket Mortgage Classic, marking the biggest move in the FedExCup standings
- 1,902** Three-time John Deere Classic champion (2009-2011) Steve Stricker has earned 1,902 total FedExCup points at this event, most of any player since 2009
