Things to Know

- Lucas Glover earns fourth PGA TOUR title and first in more than 10 years
- Glover earns seventh win by a player aged 40 or older on TOUR this season
- Five-time winner Kevin Na records 10th runner-up finish of his PGA TOUR career
- Ryan Moore finishes T2 to earn a spot in this week's The Open Championship, should he choose to play
- Adam Schenk notches best result on TOUR in his 111th start
- Preferred lies were used in the final round

Lucas Glover (1st/-19)

- Posts three birdies on front nine before dropping a shot at No.11 and closing with five birdies in his last seven holes for final-round 64; made a six-foot par putt on the 72nd hole after finding greenside bunker with his approach
- Wins fourth PGA TOUR title in 454th start at 41 years, 7 months, 29 days
- 2009 U.S. Open champion captures first title since 2011 Wells Fargo Championship, a span of 3,717 days between victories, second-longest drought between wins by a player this season (4,074 days/Stewart Cink/2020 Fortinet Championship); first win came at 2005 FUNAI Classic at the WALT DISNEY WORLD Resort
- Collects 500 FedExCup points and moves from No. 82 to 32nd in the FedExCup standings; nine of 13 John Deere Classic champions have qualified for the season-finale TOUR Championship in the FedExCup era
- Earns spots in the field at 2022 Sentry Tournament of Champions, THE PLAYERS Championship, Masters Tournament and PGA Championship
- Ranks third in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (7.096)
- Came from four strokes back after three rounds; progression after each round – T29-T3-T12-Won
- Exempt into The Open Championship next week via finishing top-30 in 2019 FedExCup standings

- Notches seventh win by a player 40 or older on TOUR this season (Stewart Cink/2, Sergio Garcia, Brian Gay, Matt Jones, Phil Mickelson)
- 64 matches low final round by a winner this season (Jason Kokrak/THE CJ CUP @ SHADOW CREEK, Si Woo Kim/The American Express, Brian Gay/Bermuda Championship); ties low round of the day with Kevin Tway (T23/-12)

Miscellaneous Notes

- **Ryan Moore** (T2/-17) earns a spot in this week's The Open Championship by finishing as the leading player (not otherwise exempt) among the top five and ties; should Moore choose not to accept the exemption, the player who is first on the reserve list will take that spot (currently Adam Long); moves from No. 194 on the FedExCup standings to 136th and has never missed the FedExCup Playoffs in all 14 seasons since it was instituted in 2007
- **Kevin Na** (T2/-17) posts second top-10 result in his eighth John Deere Classic start; lone top-10 finish of T8 came in 2016; was seeking his second title of the 2020-21 season (Sony Open in Hawaii) and sixth overall
- **Adam Schenk** (T4/-16) notches his best finish on TOUR in 111 starts; second consecutive top-10 at John Deere Classic (T6/2019) and fifth of his career
- Second-round leader **Luke List** (T4/-16) was seeking his first PGA TOUR victory in his 193rd start; owns two runner-up results (T2/2016 Sanderson Farms Championship, lost playoff to Justin Thomas at 2018 The Honda Classic)
- **Scott Brown** (T4/-16) ranks first in Strokes Gained: Putting (8.050); made 399'10" total putts for the week
- Third-round leader **Sebastian Munoz** (T4/-16) was seeking his second TOUR title (2019 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- **Hank Lebioda** (T8/-15) posts final-round 65, marking his seventh consecutive final round of par or better dating to 2021 Valspar Championship in May; marks his third consecutive top-10 (T5/Travelers Championship, T4/Rocket Mortgage Classic, T8/John Deere Classic) and fifth of his career
- **Seamus Power** (T8/-15) mixed six birdies with a lone bogey en route to a final-round 66, moving to No. 123 in the FedExCup; this week marks his eighth consecutive made cut, a first for him in any single season on TOUR; sat No. 205 in the FedExCup after his last missed cut (2021 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am)
- Past champions **Zach Johnson** (T34/-10) and **Steve Stricker** (T41/-9) both close with 71 (E); the pair sit No. 1 and No. 2, respectively, most under-par at the John Deere Classic: Johnson (192-under/19 starts), Stricker (186-under/18 starts)
- Sponsor exemption and 2019 APGA Player of the Year **Willie Mack III** (T64/-3) completes 72 holes for the second week in a row on TOUR after finishing T71 at last week's Rocket Mortgage Classic
- Of the 13 players competing this week also scheduled to compete in next week's Open Championship at Royal St. George's Golf Club, **Lucas Glover** (Won/-19) performed the best this week: **Sebastian Munoz** (T4/-16), **Russell Henley** (T11/-14), **Chez Reavie** (T18/-13), **Rafa Cabrera Bello** (T23/-12), **Daniel Berger** (T34/-10), **Zach Johnson** (T34/-10), **Byeong Hun An** (MC), **Brian Harman** (MC), **Keith Mitchell** (MC), **Alex Noren** (MC), **C.T. Pan** (MC), **Danny Lee** (WD)
