Extended Forecast – The low-pressure system is expected to slowly move across the Midwest, keeping scattered showers and thunderstorms over the region on Saturday. The low is expected to move across South-Central Illinois Sunday producing areas of rain and isolated thunderstorms. The rain will be heavy at times over the next couple of days with rainfall amounts averaging 1-3 inches over the region through Sunday. The chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms will decrease on Monday as the low-pressure system finally starts to pull away.
