

Today: – A decaying thunderstorm complex will continue to slowly weaken as it moves to the east this morning. Areas of light rain will be likely over the next couple of hours before dissipating. Otherwise, mostly cloudy skies can be expected with scattered showers and thunderstorms redeveloping during the afternoon into the evening as a low-pressure system moves east along the Iowa border.

Sunday's Forecast – A low-pressure system will be moving into Central Illinois and stalling over the state. Rain will be likely through the morning hours into the early afternoon before the precipitation become more scattered in nature during the afternoon. Can't rule out isolated thunderstorms, especially during the afternoon. Rain may be heavy at times with 1.00-1.50" of total rainfall expected.
