Cannot rule out a few thunderstorms, especially during the afternoon with the heating of the day. It will be breezy with northeast winds 10-15 gusting to 20-25 mph at times. Rainfall could be heavy at times as well with total rainfall averaging 0.50"-1.00" by the end of the day.
