Masters Tournament 7 AM Weather Update Friday, November 13, 2020



Synopsis: Low clouds and any fog patches that may develop near daybreak should quickly burn off after sunrise. Skies will remain mostly cloudy through mid-morning before gradually becoming sunny by noon. Drier/less humid air will continue to filter into the region making for comfortable conditions. Fall-like temperatures can be expected Saturday into Sunday with lows in the 50s and highs in the 70s. The next cold front is forecast to move through the CSRA Sunday evening, but no precipitation is anticipated. Much cooler temperatures return early next week.
