7 AM Weather Update

Saturday, November 14, 2020



Synopsis: The thin area of clouds should burn-off quickly after sunrise allowing for mostly sunny skies to return for the rest of the day. Temperatures in the mid to upper 50s will likely warm into the low to mid 70s this afternoon making for comfortable conditions. Low clouds and patchy fog may redevelop overnight as the humidity slightly increases. Otherwise warmer temperatures will return Sunday ahead of an approaching cold front that will move through the area late in the day. This front will be moisture starved with no precipitation is expected as it passes. Much cooler air returns on Monday with highs in the upper 60s.
