

# Masters Tournament

## 7 AM Weather Update

### Sunday, November 15, 2020



**Synopsis:** Any low clouds or fog patches in the area are forecast to lift by 9am. Partly cloudy skies are then anticipated for the remainder of the morning and through the afternoon with a high temperature in the upper 70s. Southwesterly winds will become breezy between 11am-12pm, with anticipated wind gusts of 15-20 mph. A cold front will move through the CSRA after sunset, but this boundary remains moisture-starved. Precipitation chances will be 10% or less this afternoon and evening as the front approaches the area, with any precipitation being in the form of brief sprinkles. Clearing skies behind the front overnight, with temperatures dropping into the middle to upper 40s.

5 PM: Partly cloudy.  
Temp: 74F            RH: 65%  
Winds: WSW 10-15 mph

1 PM: Partly cloudy and breezy.  
Temp: 77F            RH: 65%  
Winds: SW 10-15 G20 mph

7 PM: Mostly cloudy.  
Temp: 70F            RH: 70%  
Winds: W 10-15 mph
