Masters Tournament 7 AM Weather Forecast Saturday, April 10, 2021



Synopsis: The day is starting off cloudy here at Augusta National with temperatures in the upper 50's. Cloudy skies will continue through the day with increasing winds as a weather system steadily approaches from the west. Southerly winds pick up into this afternoon and become the strongest of the tournament, sustained at 12-18 mph with gusts of 20-25 mph for a 3-to-4-hour period this afternoon. Showers and thunderstorms are then expected to move into the Augusta area between 4-7 PM with conditions then drying out heading into this evening as rain shifts to the east. Rainfall of 0.10-0.30" can be expected if the rain and storms indeed hold together as anticipated and move over the course. After some patchy fog early Sunday morning, a cold front moves through by early afternoon and this will keep a chance of a few showers in the forecast before the sunshine and pleasant conditions return. Southwest winds turn west for the final round at 10-15 mph with gusts up to 20 mph possible during the afternoon hours.
