Synopsis: Low clouds have been overspreading the area from the west making for cloudy skies to start the day. Mostly cloudy skies will continue through the morning hours with temperatures in the 60s. Otherwise, a cold front will move through Augusta around midday/early afternoon, keeping a chance of a few showers in the forecast between 12pm and 3pm before partly cloudy skies and drier air returns for the rest of the day. Any thunderstorms are expected to remain south and east of Augusta this afternoon as the front pushes to the east. Southwest winds turn west at 10-15 mph with some higher gusts are expected during the afternoon hours. Sunny skies and warm temperatures return Monday as high pressure builds over the region with highs in the mid-80s.
