FINAL Second-Round Notes – Saturday, December 5, 2020

Weather: Mostly cloudy with a high of 82. Wind E/ESE 4-8 mph, with gusts to 10 mph

Due to darkness Friday, the second round was suspended for the day at 6:10 p.m. ET. Eighteen players were back in position at 7:58 a.m. Saturday morning. Round two concluded at 8:42 a.m. and round three will begin at 10:20 a.m.

36-hole cut: 71 players at 1-under 141 from a field of 130 professionals and two amateurs

Things to Know

- Emiliano Grillo ties his lowest round of his PGA TOUR career with 8-under 63
- Grillo extends his streak of par-or-better rounds at Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN to a perfect 18-for-18
- Tony Finau seeks second career PGA TOUR victory and first since the 2016 Puerto Rico Open
- Guadalajara native Carlos Ortiz sits T8 and seeks to win in back-to-back PGA TOUR starts
- Making his first PGA TOUR start as professional, 2019 U.S. Amateur champion Andy Ogletree is inside the top 10

- Tied the lowest round of his PGA TOUR career (63/R3/2019 Sony Open in Hawaii)
- Recorded his personal best for most birdies (16) through 36 holes at a TOUR event
- Marks his second 36-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR (2020 Puerto Rico Open/T3)
- Making fifth consecutive start at the Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN (three top-15 finishes in four previous starts)
- Made six of seven cuts in the 2020-21 PGA TOUR Season, highlighted by a T18 at The RSM Classic
- Owns one PGA TOUR victory: 2015 Safeway Open (defeated Kevin Na in a playoff)
- Advanced to the FedExCup Playoffs in all five seasons as a PGA TOUR member (2016-2020)

Additional Notes

- In his fifth start of the season, **Tony Finau** (-9/T2) carded a 5-under 66, where he got up-and-down six of seven times and only needed 24 putts; In 168 career starts on TOUR, owns 40 top-10 finishes and one victory
- Making his sixth Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN start, **Tom Hoge** (-9/T2) posted a 4-under 67, which included five birdies and one bogey; best finish at this event is a T44 in 2014
- With a 2-under 69, 18-hole leader **Russell Knox** (-8/4th) set to make his eighth consecutive cut at this event, where he has finished inside the top 10 in three of his last four starts
- Viktor Hovland (-6/T8) expected to make his 17th consecutive cut on TOUR with a 2-under 69 (third longest active streak)
- Making his first start since claiming his maiden PGA TOUR title at the Vivint Houston Open, Carlos Ortiz (-6/T8) seeks to become the first player to win in back-to-back PGA TOUR starts since Brendon Todd achieved the feat at this event in 2019
- In his bid to become the event's first player to successfully defend his title, Brendon Todd sits T8 at 6-under 136
- Making his first PGA TOUR start as a professional, 2019 U.S. Amateur champion **Andy Ogletree** returned Saturday morning to play his last three holes, resulting in a 4-under 67 and will head into round three at 6-under 136 (T8)
- Of the six players representing Mexico this week, two players will advance to the weekend: Carlos Ortiz (-6/T8), Abraham Ancer (-3/T33), Roberto Diaz (+1/T81), Armando Favela (+5/T113), Aaron Terrazas (+5/T113) and Monday qualifier Isidro Benitez (+12/T129)
- Kiradech Aphibarnrat withdrew during the second round with an ankle injury
- Cameron Percy withdrew during round two Saturday morning
