Things to Know

- Viktor Hovland notches second career PGA TOUR victory in his 35th career start
- Hovland becomes the fifth European player since 1945 with multiple PGA TOUR wins before the age of 24
- Hovland becomes the youngest TOUR winner since Sungjae Im at 2020 The Honda Classic
- Austin Eckroat becomes the third amateur to shoot 65 or better in the final round of a non-major TOUR event since 1983
- Max Homa makes 11 birdies in a 13-hole stretch to finish T12
- Carlos Ortiz earned the best result among the six Mexican players in the field

- Notched second career PGA TOUR victory, following his win at the 2020 Puerto Rico Open
- At 23 years, 2 months, 18 days, became youngest TOUR winner since Sungjae Im at 2020 The Honda Classic
- Fifth European player since 1945 with multiple PGA TOUR victories before the age of 24 (Rory McIlroy/6, Seve Ballesteros/3, Sergio Garcia/3, Jon Rahm/2)
- Became the first winner of the Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN to birdie the 72nd hole
- Made his first PGA TOUR start at this event in 2018 playing as an amateur
- Owns four top-15 finishes in five starts this season (Won/2020 Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN, T15/Vivint Houston Open, T12/ THE CJ CUP @ SHADOW CREEK, T13/U.S. Open)
- Recorded 25 birdies for most in the field this week
- Missed the cut in his two previous starts at this event (2018, 2019)

Aaron Wise

- Bogey-free round of 8-under 63 tied his career-low on TOUR, marking the fourth time in his career to do so (R3/2016 John Deere Classic, R2/2018 AT&T Byron Nelson, R3/2018 Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN)
- Owns three top-20 finishes in seven starts this season on TOUR (2nd/2020 Mayakoba Golf Classic presented by UNIFIN, T11/Vivint Houston Open, T17/Sanderson Farms Championship)

- Notched his second top-10 in five appearances at this event (2nd/2020, T10/2018)
- 2017-18 PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year

Additional Notes

- Following a T2 finish at this event last year, **Adam Long** (-17/T3) owns a scoring average of 66.50 (eight rounds) at El Camaleon GC
- **Tom Hoge** (-17/T3) carded a 2-under 69 in the final round for his best result on TOUR since a runner-up at 2019 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier
- After finishing the third round with five consecutive birdies, **Max Homa** (-14/T12) birdied six of his first eight holes in the final round (11 birdies in a 13-hole stretch) en route to a 6-under 65
- With a final-round 6-under 65, **Austin Eckroat** (-14/T12) becomes the third amateur to shoot 65 or better in the final round of a non-major TOUR event since 1983 (64/Joaquin Niemann/2017 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier, 65/Braden Thornberry/2017 FedEx St. Jude Classic)
- Of the six players representing Mexico this week, **Carlos Ortiz** recorded the best performance finishing T8 at 15-under
- In his bid to become the event's first player to successfully defend his title, **Brendon Todd** finished T8 at 15-under 269
